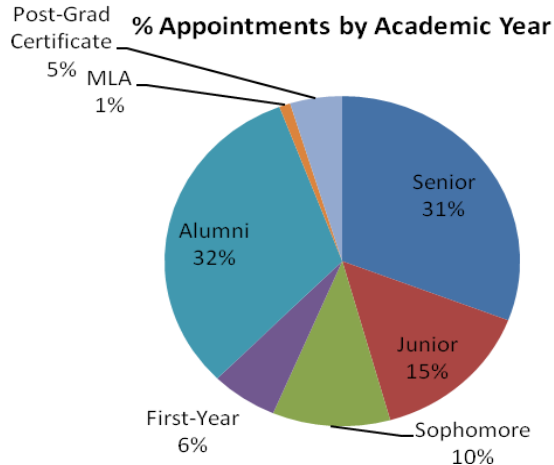


### Annual Report Highlights: Fall 2011 - Spring 2012

#### Student Outreach

- Career Center staff conducted 86 presentations (63 classroom presentations; 23 other on-campus presentations).
- The Career Center hosted 9 career and professional development programs, events, and workshops.
- Career Counselors conducted 973 individual student appointments (31% Seniors; 15% Juniors; 11% Sophomores; 6% Freshmen; 32% Alumni; 1% MLA; 5% Post-Grad Certificate).



#### Student Employment

- **Total students employed on-campus:** 741
- **Average Hourly Wage:** \$8.09/hour

#### Internship and Experiential Programs

- **Internships for credit:** 201 students pursued internships for academic credit.
- **Experiential-learning, project, and practicum courses:** 286 students received credit for these types of courses.
- **Internship postings:** 291 internship opportunities were posted online through the Career Center's website.
- **Summary:** 487 students were earning academic credit for internships and other experiential-learning opportunities.

#### Employer Relations

- **Employers Recruiting On-Campus: 124**
  - **Career & Graduate School Fair 2011:** 66 employers & schools - 189 students, alumni and community members in attendance.
  - **Job and Internship Fair 2012:** 44 employers - 304 students, alumni and community members in attendance.
  - **On-Campus Recruiting Interviews, Information Tables and Sessions:** 14 visits by 14 employers.
- **Online Job Postings:** 1,085 jobs & internships were posted online for students and alumni to review
  - **Full-Time Job Postings:** 452
  - **Part-Time Jobs:** 368 (*\*Note – 26 of these positions were listed as “part time job or paid internship,” and are also included in internship data above*)
- **Liberal Arts Career Panels: International Careers, Women's Wisdom Exchange, Alumni Job Search Boot Camp and Technology Careers –** 21 employer panelists in four workshops.

#### Alumni Relations

- **28 Alumni** Assisted with Career Center events and programming
- **Alumni Career Counseling Appointments:** 31% of appointments were UNC Asheville Alumni (304 of 973).
